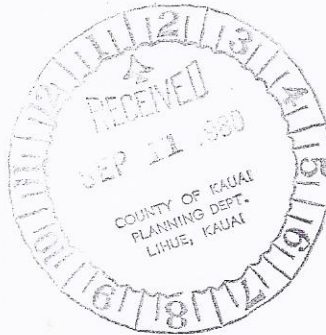

Dear Mr. Mamacalay:

Per your request, the property owned by Harry Steward in Haena, Kauai (TMK: 5-8-12:7, Lot 82) was surveyed by the Department of Health on September 5, 1980. The distance between the edge of the proposed cesspool and the ocean was over fifty (50) feet. The measurement was taken during high tide.

Based on the above finding, the use of cesspool will be allowed by the Department of Health.

However, a dye test to determine that the wastewater will not contaminate the ocean will be required by the Department of Health.
